And, there were a few who went 10-11 years with us before moving away, but they are still '43 Kewpie classmates.

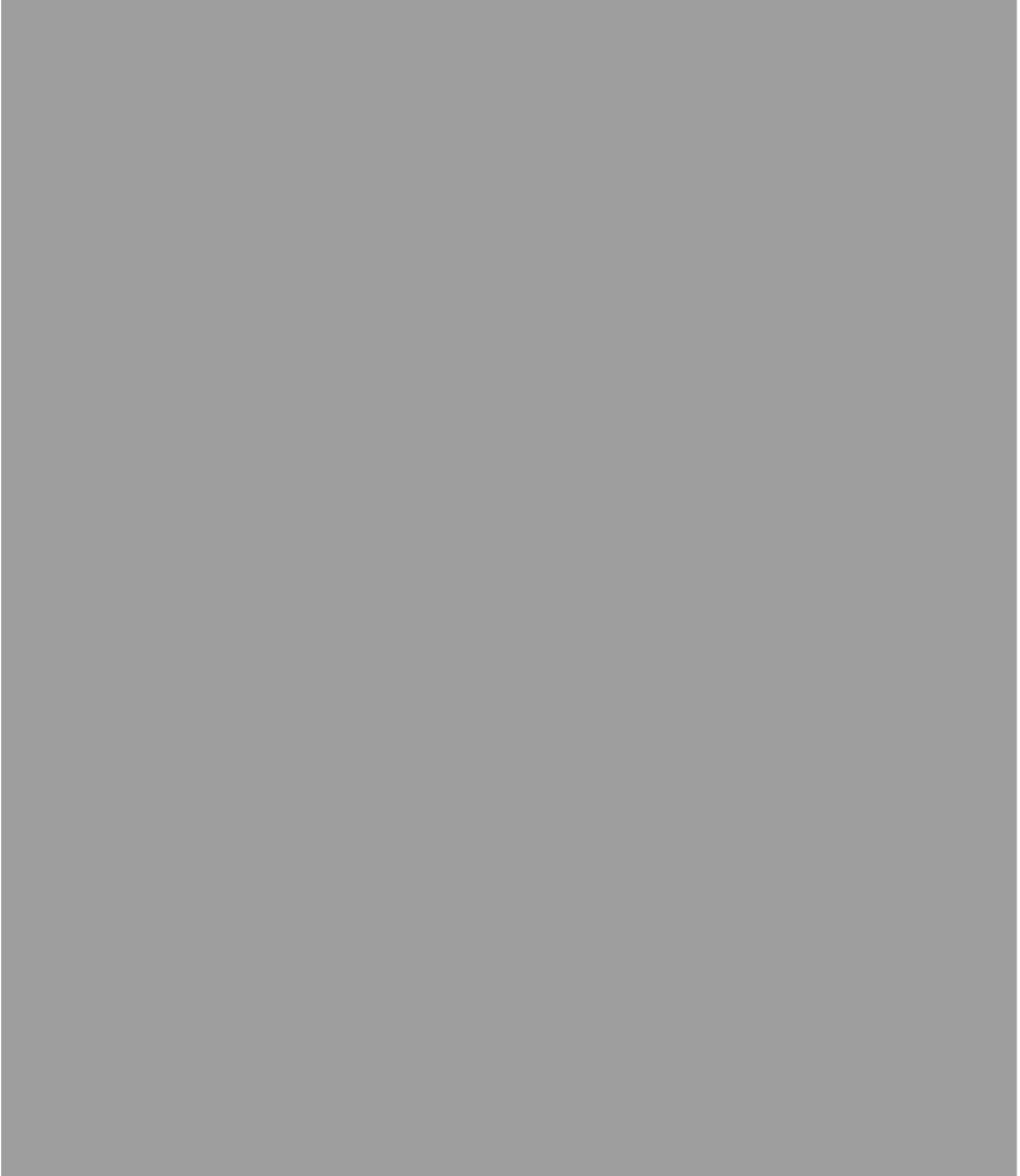

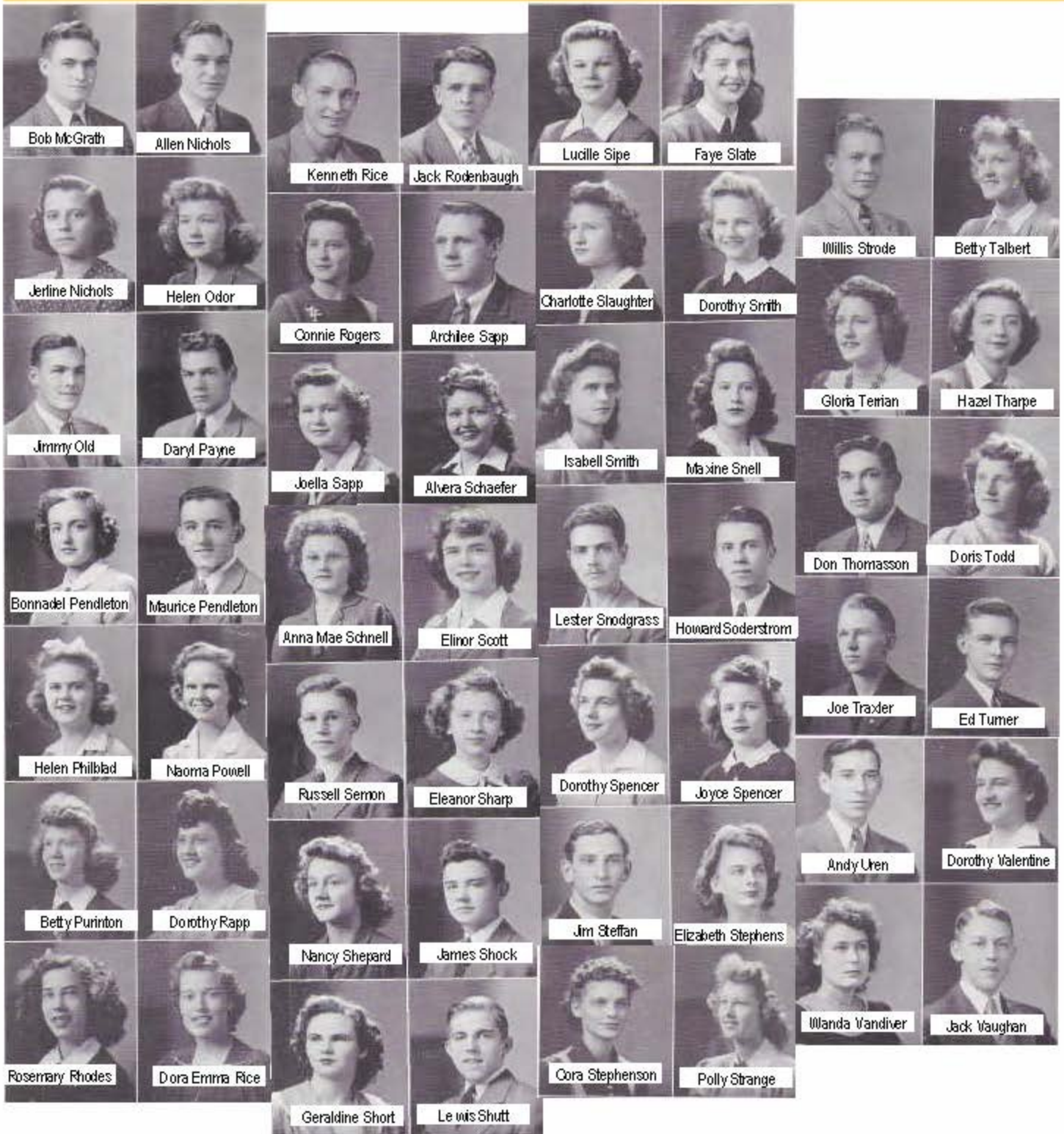
