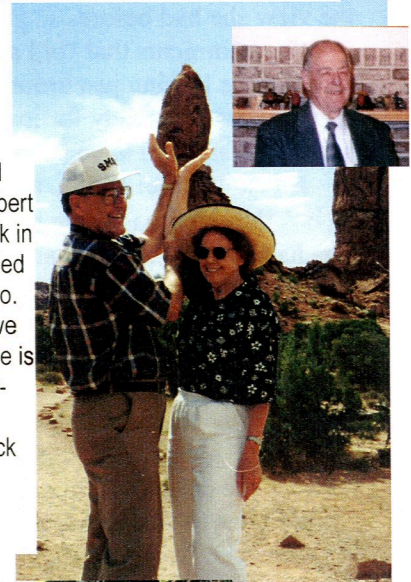

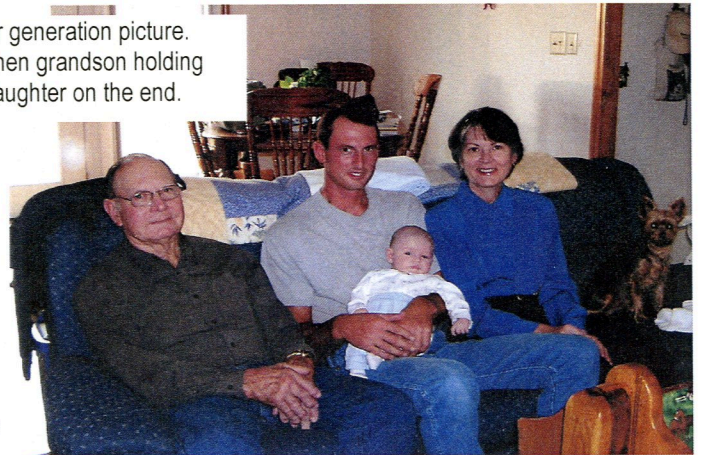

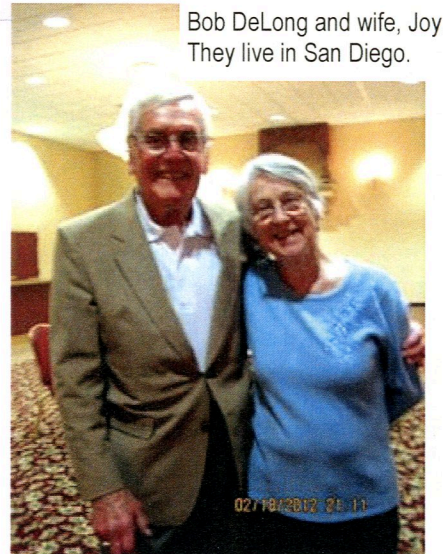

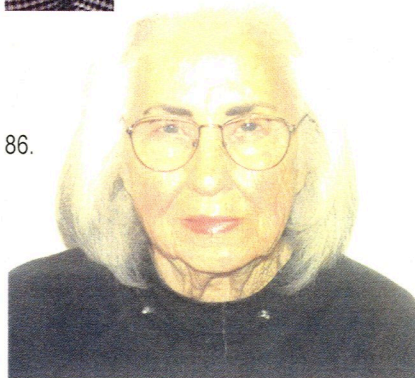

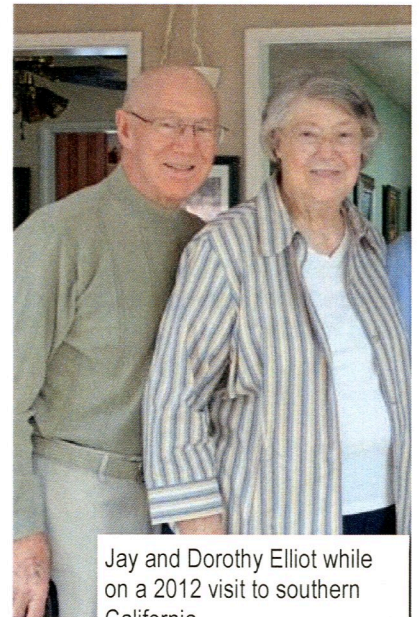

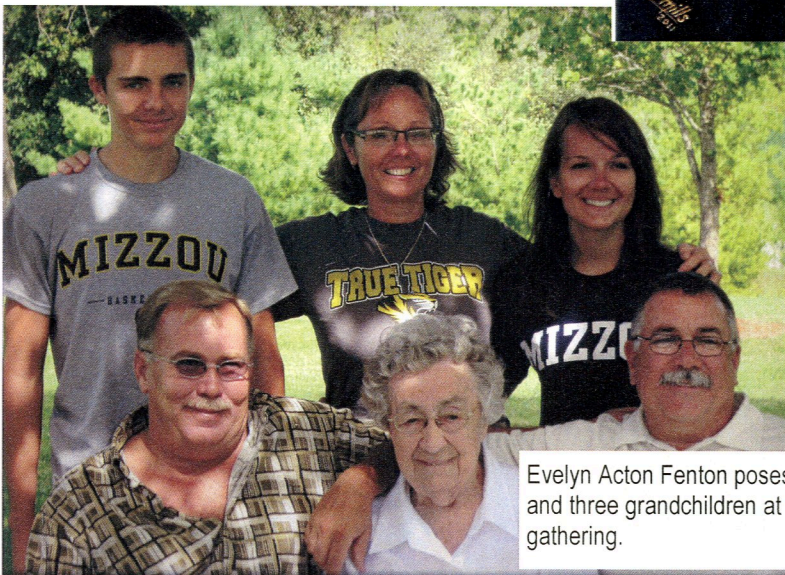

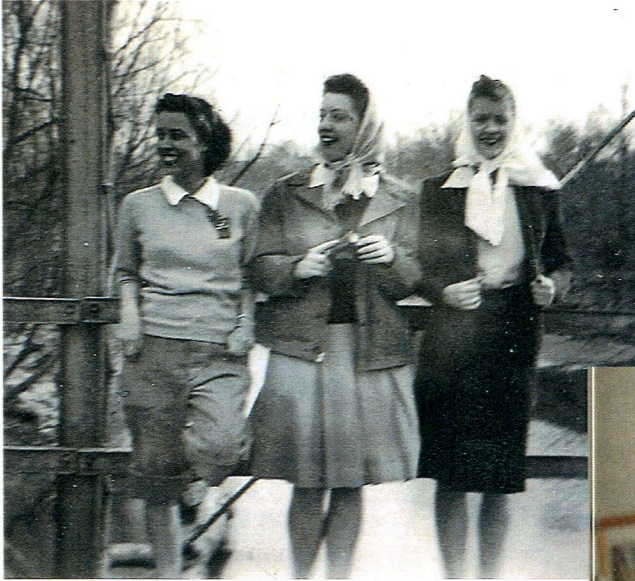
Address Unknown
