The "Heart for Hickman" campaign, which raises money for the stage project, runs through February. Right now, PTSA has \$10,500 to spend on the project. The total cost is \$25,643. - This is that this is the first year in more than 30 that all Hickman students have been able to gather together in one indoor space for an all-school assembly? The student body was too large before Battle High was built, and no space was large enough before the new gym was added.
- That Hickman is the <u>only</u> public high school in Columbia that does not have a dedicated space for an indoor all-school assembly?
- That the auditorium will be closed in April for renovations? This means HHS students will have no place to celebrate awards, concerts, memories their own at the end of the year without this stage.
- That hosting one assembly for all students instead of two gives our kids more class time?
- That students feel more connected, more community, more KEWPIE PRIDE when they can all be together and share the same energy and excitement?
- That athletes and cheerleaders will work the crowd into a frenzy from this stage at pep rallies?

- That the band will pump the crowd up from this stage at pep rallies?
- That the spotlight will shine on academic teams and Science Olympians on this stage?
- That the drama department will entertain with play cuts here?
- That this stage will be an important part of your child's high school experience?
- That this stage will be an important part of Hickman's future?
